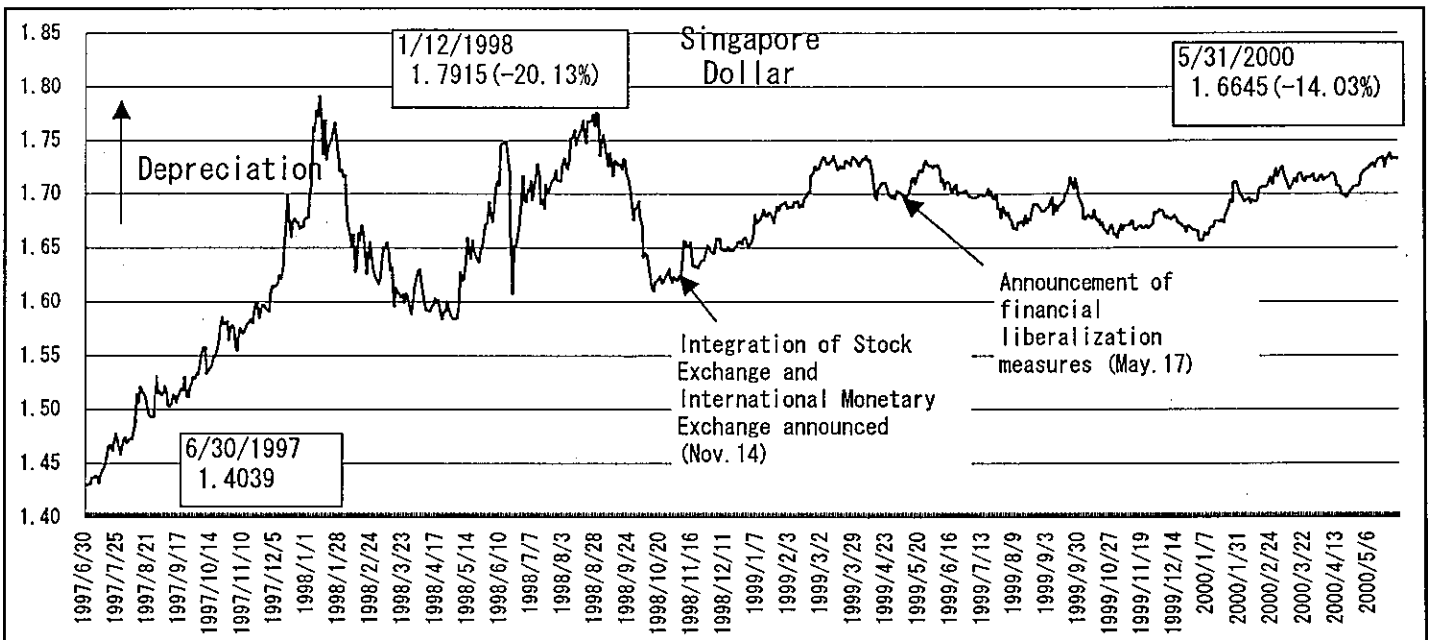
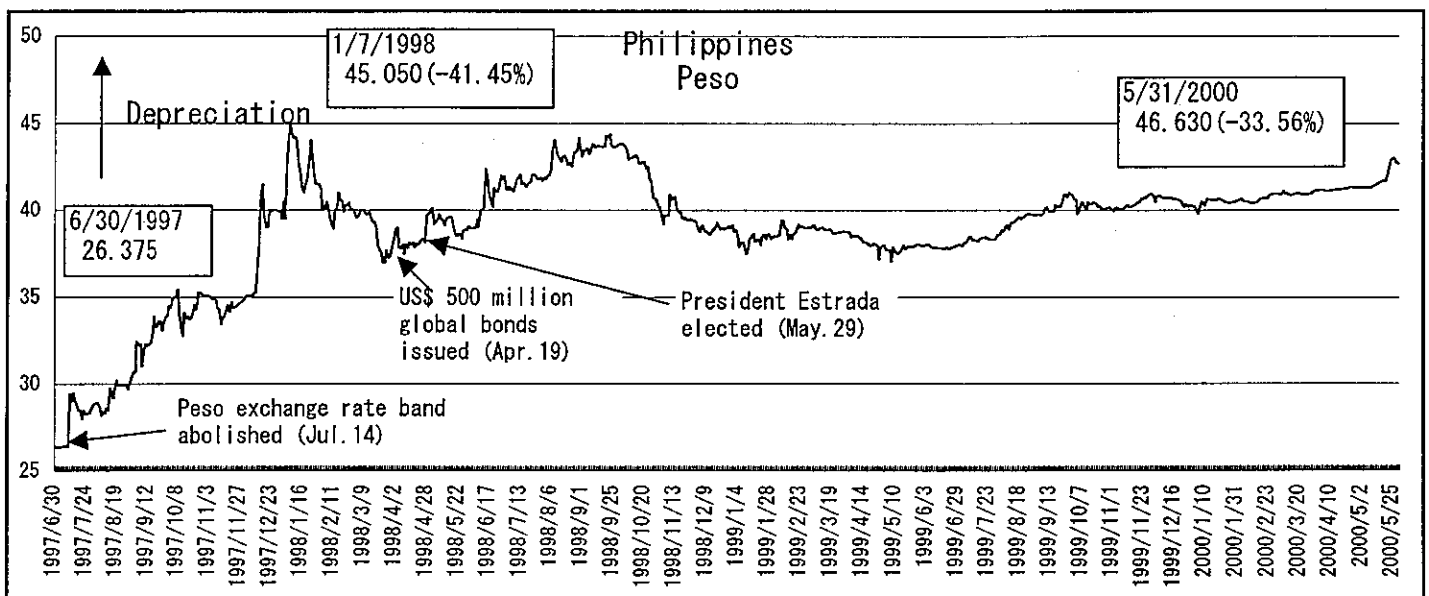
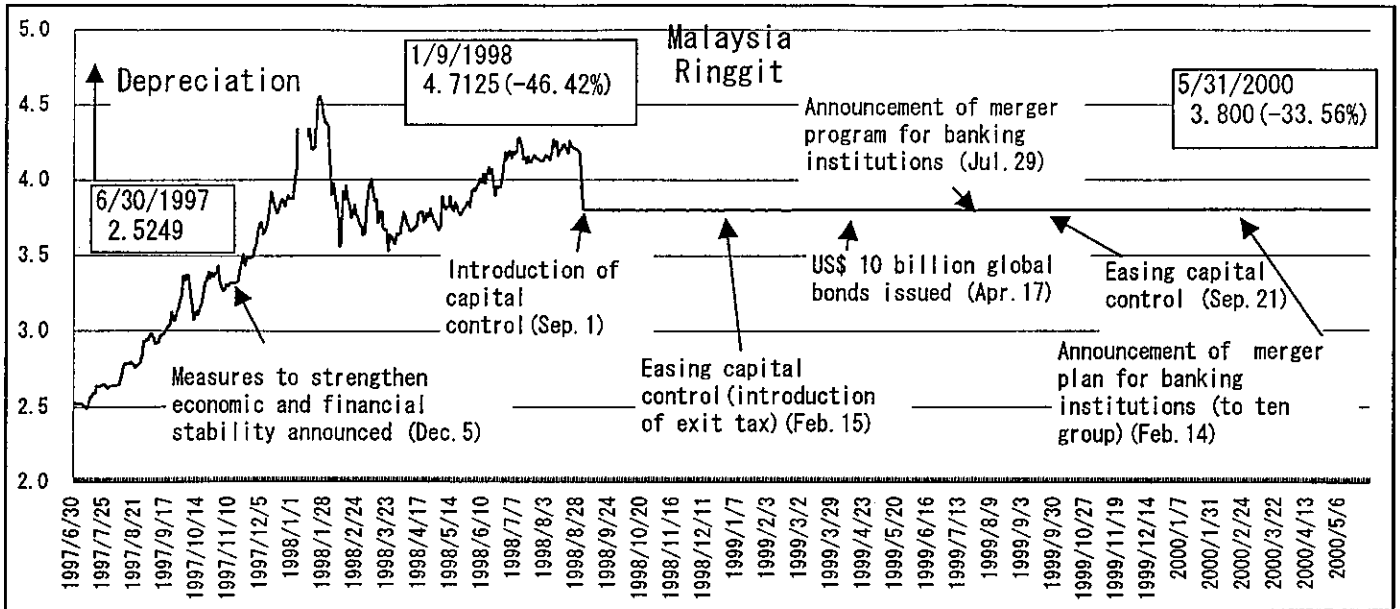

(5) Exchange Rates to U.S. Dollar of Selected Asian Economies (since June 30, 1997)



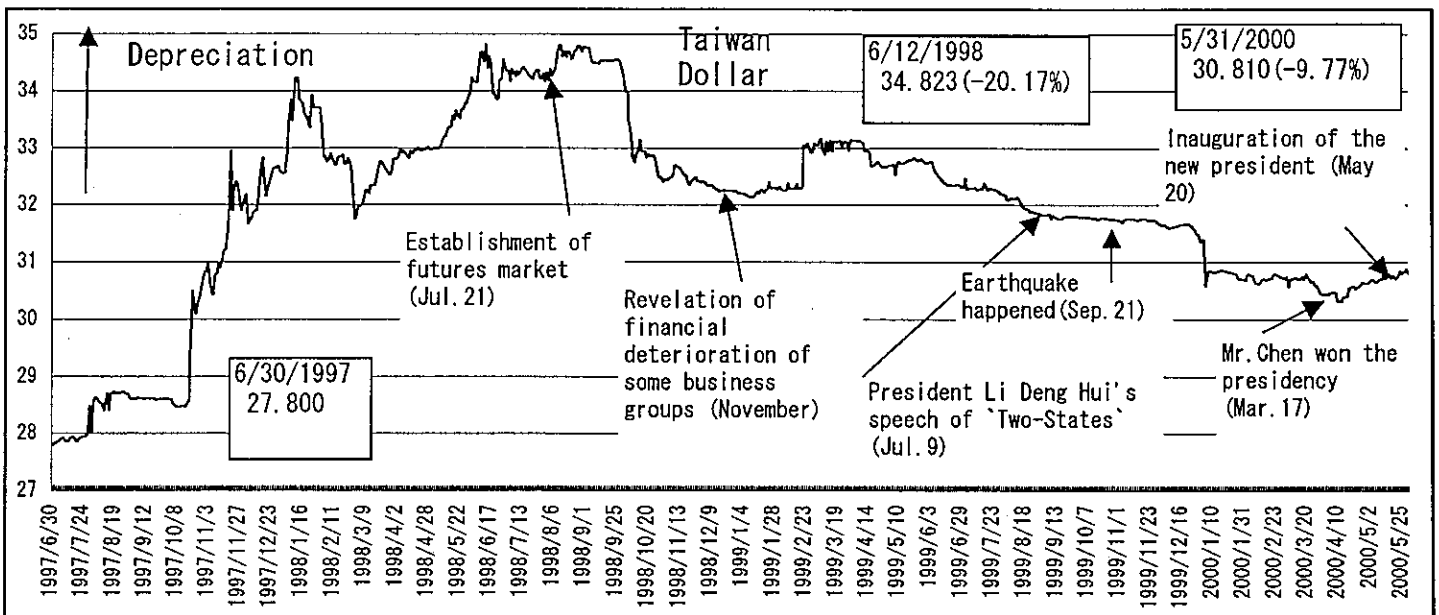
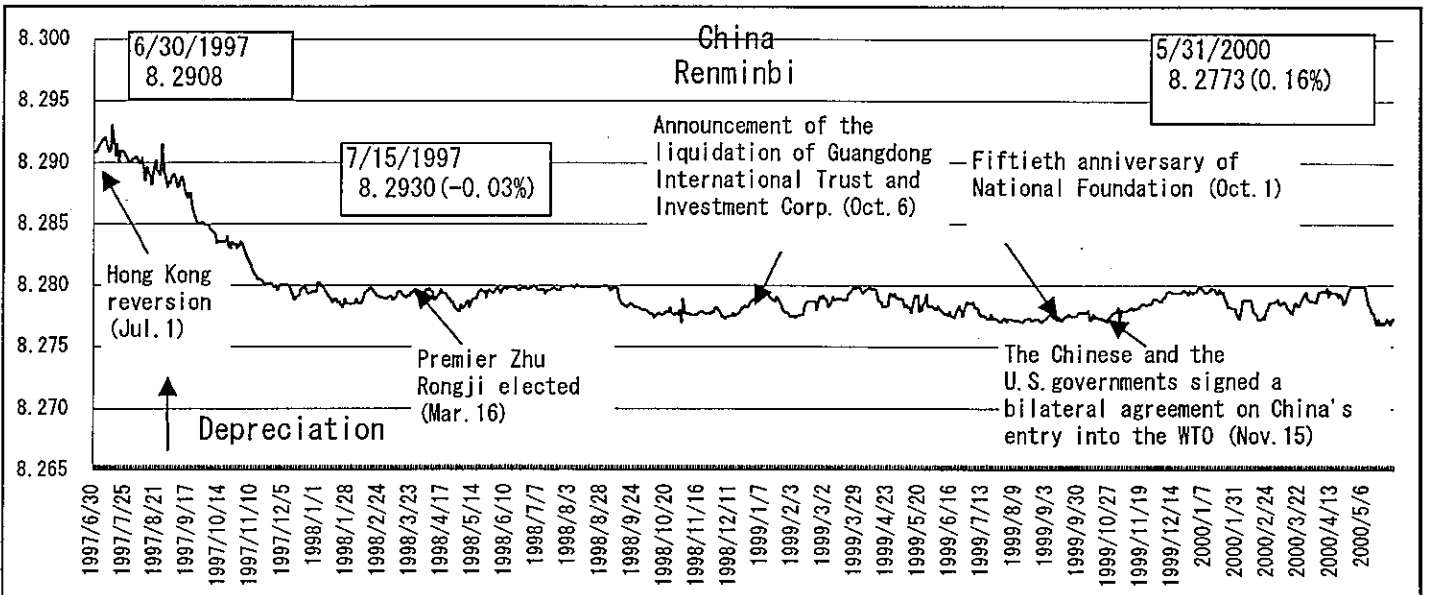
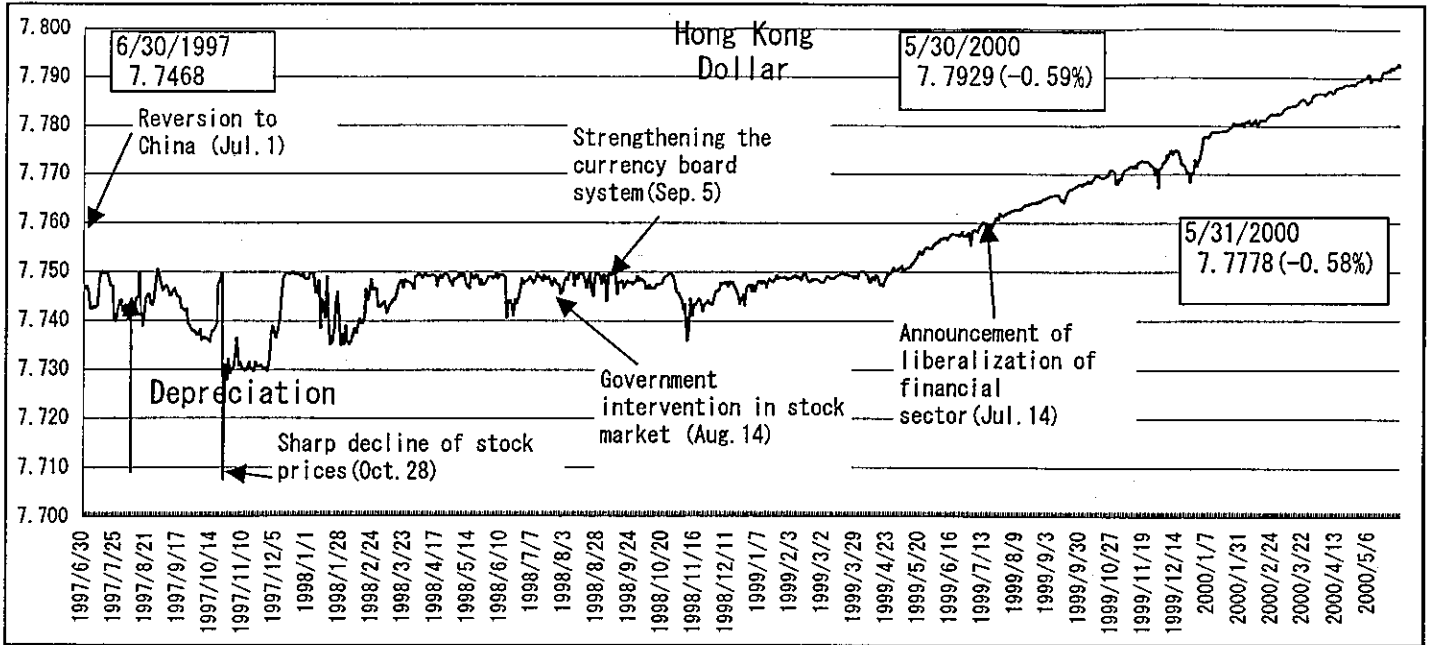

## Exchange Rates to U.S. Dollar of Selected Asian Economies (since June 30, 1997)



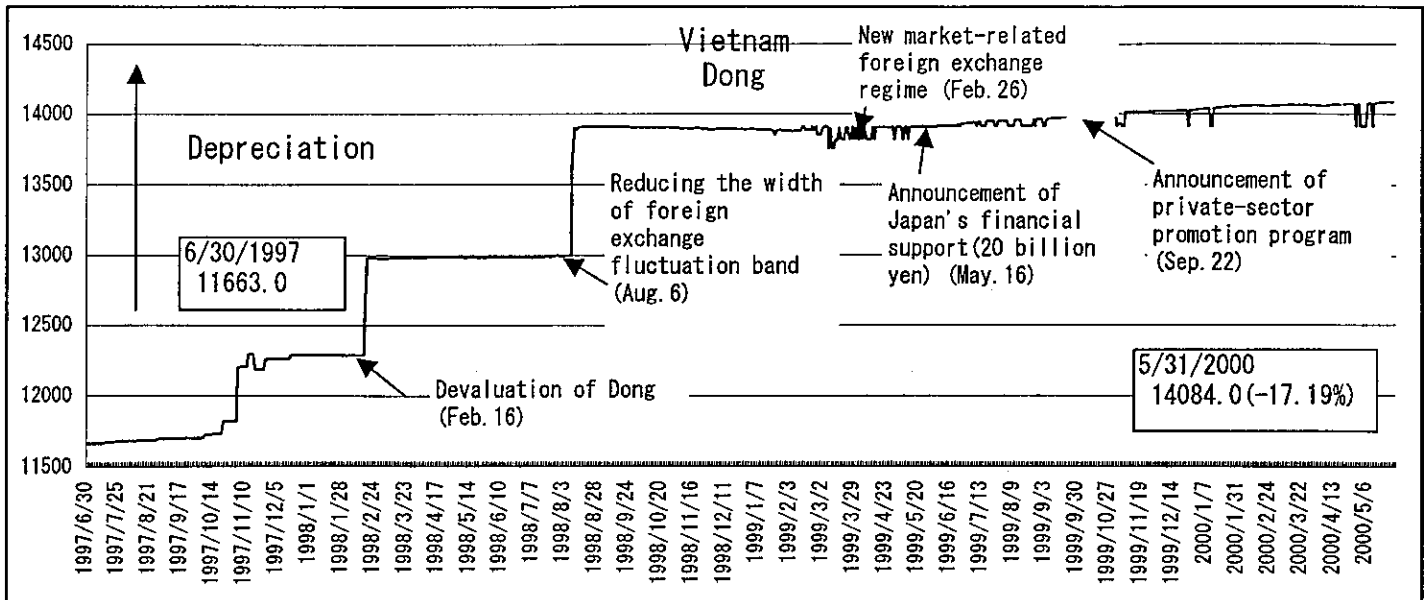
