Outline of the Supplementary Budget for FY2016

For responding to the Kumamoto earthquake in this April, the government allocated budget to support the victims by providing houses and assistance to promote reconstruction of livelihood.

In addition, the government newly established “Reserve fund to recover from the Kumamoto earthquake” to prepare enough money for the future disbursement such as reconstructing businesses, restoring infrastructures and clearing debris so as to advance the recovery more promptly.
