- (Note 2) The 10,000-yen gold coin and 1,000-yen silver coins will only be available through mail-order to the Japan Mint. The sales information, including ordering procedures, will be announced in the sales guidelines to be released immediately before the commencement of accepting orders. Please make inquiries to the Japan Mint on July, 2018, onward.
- (Note 3) The latent images are different for the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 1,000-yen commemorative silver coin and the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games 1,000-yen commemorative silver coin. See the Attachments of References 2 and 4 for details.
- (Note 4) Regarding the helical ridges on the edges of the 100-yen clad coins, while the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games commemorative coin has wide-spaced ridges, the Olympic Games Tokyo 2020 has narrow-spaced ridges so that they can be distinguished also by touching their edges.
- (Note 5) The number of 100-yen clad coins to be issued will be decided by Cabinet Order in consideration of requests from financial institutions that handle exchange thereof.
- (Note 6) The 100-yen clad coins are circulated by being exchanged at their face value over the counter at financial institutions. The exchange guidelines will be announced later by the Ministry of Finance.
