Athletics and Sepaktakraw, with the Main Stadium



- The design features an athlete and a sepaktakraw player, with the Nagoya City Mizuho Park Athletic Stadium, the main stadium for the 2026 Games.

Reverse (1.5x view/Actual size view)

HONOHON and Flame



- The design features HONOHON, the mascot for the 20th Asian Games, with a flare.
 - The flame is designed using iridescent color shining technology.(*)

(*) Iridescent color shining technology is a technique that creates an iridescent shine on a metal surface by the light interference, which is caused by reflecting off microgrooves engraved on the surface. It features that the processed part shines in different colors when viewed from different angles.
