Explanation of the Design of the 100th year of Showa 1,000-Yen Silver Coin

Obverse (1.5x enlargement / actual size)

“Shinkansen, Tokyo Tower, Expressways, People of the Showa Era, and the “100th year of Showa” Initiatives Logo Design”



- The design combines symbols of postwar reconstruction and high economic growth— such as the Shinkansen, Tokyo Tower, and expressways— together with people of the Showa era and the “100th year of Showa” initiatives logo design.

Reverse (1.5x enlargement / actual size)

“Mt. Fuji, Cherry Blossoms, and Doves”



- The design uses Mt. Fuji and cherry blossoms, which were featured on Japan’s first commemorative coin issued during the Showa era (for the Tokyo Olympic Games), and also incorporates doves as a symbol of peace.
