(Note3) The issuance of the 10-Year Inflation-Indexed Bonds in FY2011 may be resumed if the market condition allows. In such case, the product designs may be reviewed such as provision of principal guarantees at maturity.

(Note4) Details of Auctions for Enhanced-Liquidity will be determined on a quarterly basis taking market conditions into consideration.
