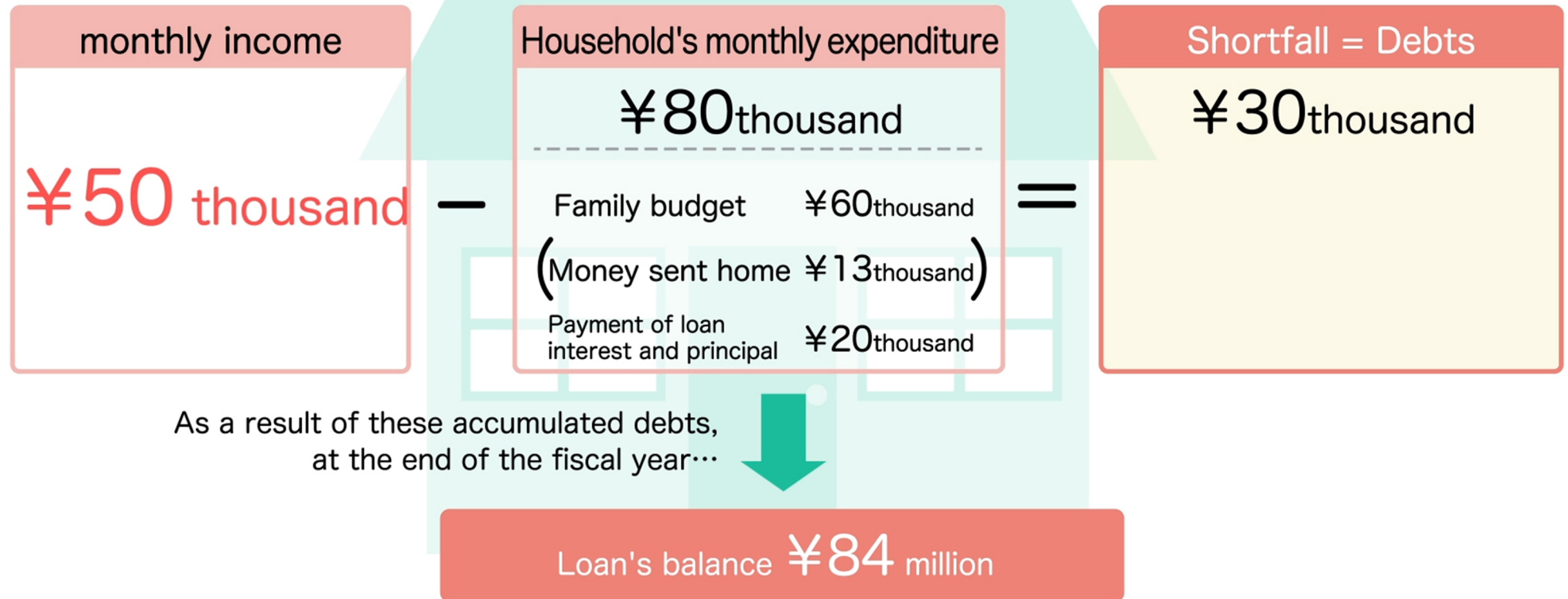

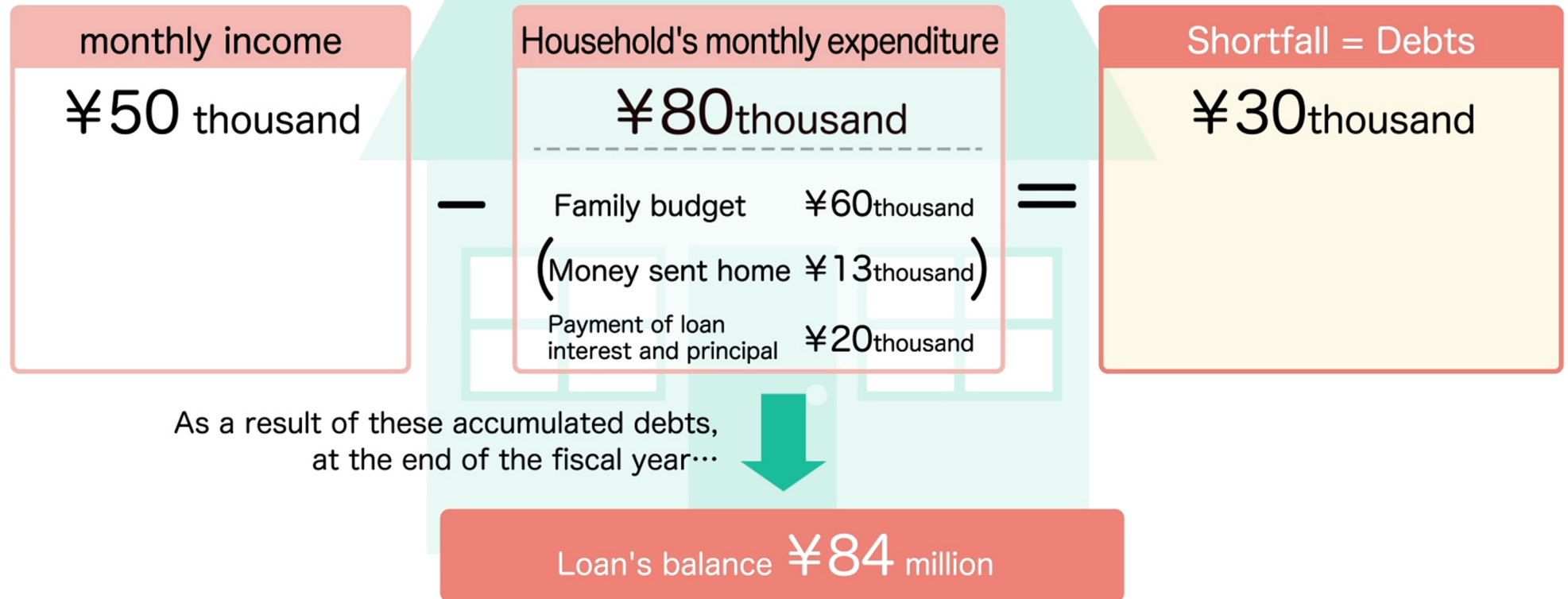

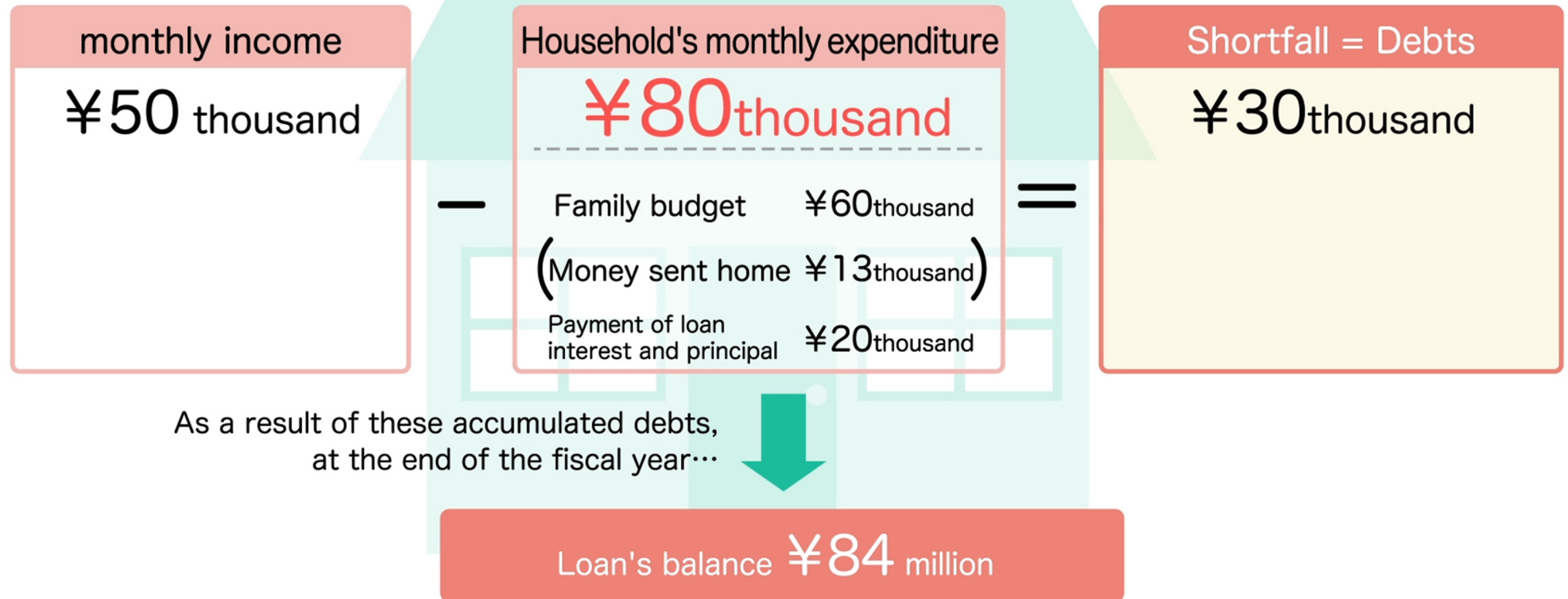

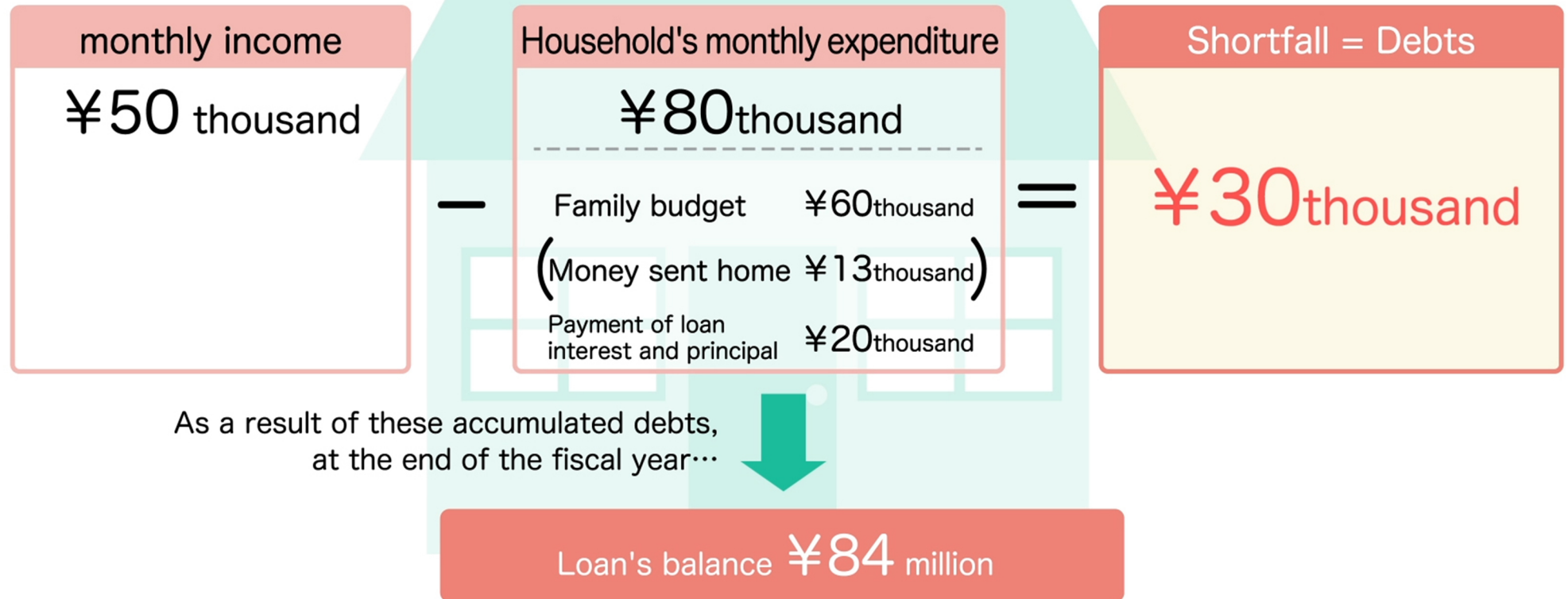

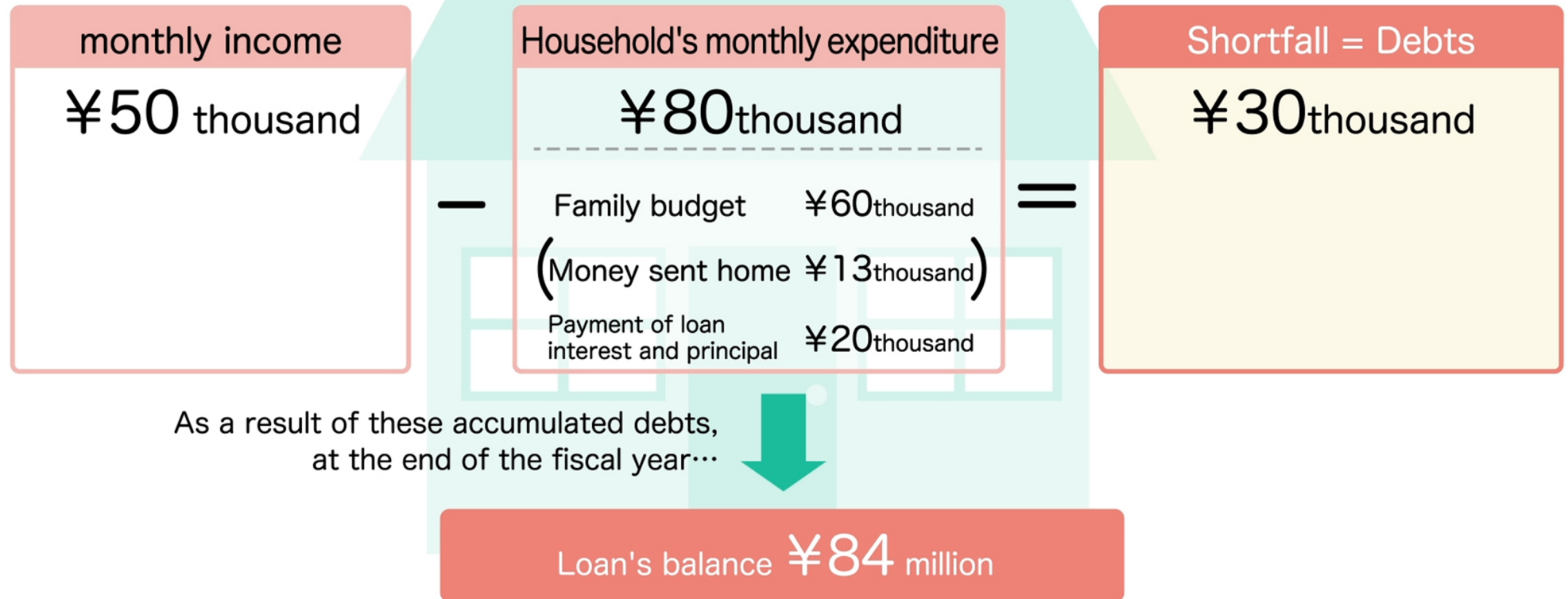


As a result of these accumulated debts,

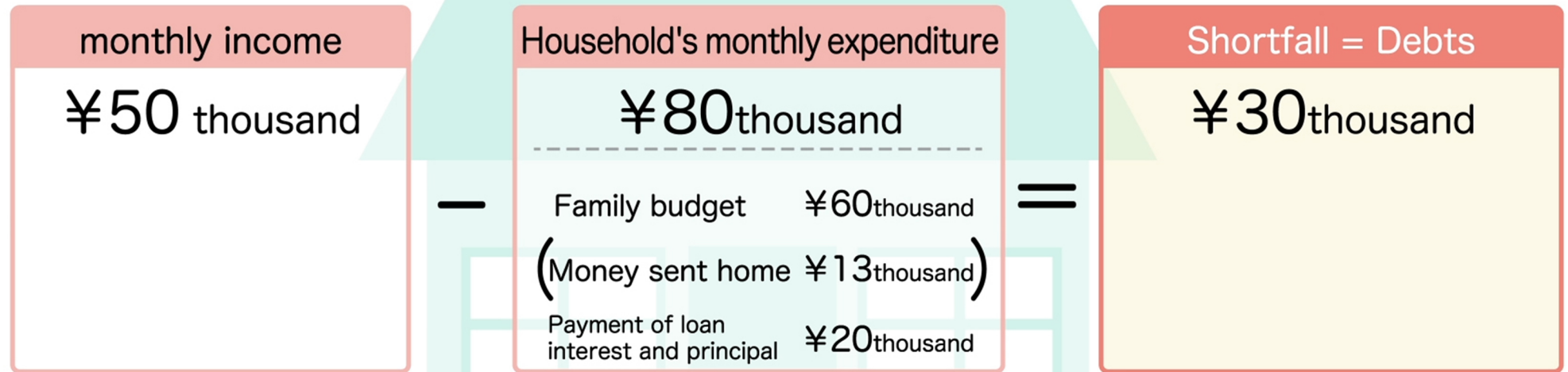
